Course Description:

The STCW Basic Safety Training course is comprised of four U.S. Coast Guard approved courses: Personal Survival at Sea, Elementary First Aid, Personal Safety, and Social Responsibility & Basic Marine Firefighting. The course is designed to meet or exceed the mandatory minimum requirements as set forth in STCW Code, Chapter VI, Section A-VI/1, Tables A-VI/1-1, A-VI/11-3 and A-VI/1-4 respectively. The course is conducted as a combination of classroom and practical hands-on training.
