Course Description:

The STCW Medical First Aid Provider course is designed to provide the training for candidates to administer medical first aid on board ship, in accordance with Section A-VI/4 of the STCW Code. This course aims to provide seafarers with the knowledge and skills so that they can administer first aid upon encountering an accident or other medical emergency onboard ship. The course is conducted as a combination of classroom and practical hands-on training.
