WHAT IS Cloud+?

CompTIA Cloud+ is a performance-based IT certification that views cloud-based infrastructure services in the context of broader IT systems operations regardless of the platform. Unlike other certifications, which may focus on a specific vendor or a single function like security or networking, Cloud+ reflects the breadth of skills needed for job roles tasked with managing and optimizing infrastructure services.

Released in June 2021, Cloud+ CV0-003 emphasizes automation and virtualization in place of hands-on cloud management. Cloud+ certified professionals will understand how to scale the cloud to meet business needs, while employing such approaches as continuous integration and delivery for a seamless end-user experience.

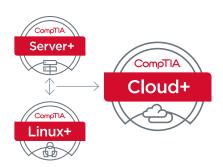
